

## MY PURPLE DREAM

This pattern is for free use, but link to my blog instead of putting the pattern in your own blog.



My socks are 70 gram, and the measure to the heel is 14 cm, so I guess you'll need from 70-100 gram.

Yarn: Arwetta (merino wool, 20% nylon) 50 gram = 210 meters

30 sts= 10 cm,

Needles: 2,5mm

K= knit

P= purl

SSK= slip slip knit

K2tog= knit 2 together

P2tog= purl 2 together

S11= slip 1 st

Cable= Slip 1 st on cable needle behind work, knit 1, then knit the one on the cable needle

Or to make it easier you can knit the 2 st first without slipping it, then knit the 1 st,

Then slip both.





Cast on 68 sts, and divide the sts on 4 needles, 17 on each needle.

Cuff:

1. K
2. P
3. K
4. P
5. K
6. P

Pattern:

The pattern is the same on all 4 needles, one time on each.

1. p1, cable, k11,cable,p1
2. p1,k15,p1
3. P1, cable, p2tog twice, yo,k1,yo,k1,yo,k1,yo,p2tog twice,cable,p1
4. p1,k15,p1

Repeat this 4 rows until you have the length you want for your leg.

Heel (34sts)

1. (right side) k1,slip1,k1,slip1, continue 'till the end, but end with k2
2. P
3. K2, sl 1, \*K1, sl 1\* continue \*.\* 'till the end, but end with K1.
4. P

Repeat these 4 rounds for about 32 rows, or until you have the heelflap long enough.

Turn heel:

1. (right side) k20, ssk,k1, turn
2. sl 1, P7, p2tog, P1, turn
3. K to the last st before the gap, ssk, k1, turn
4. P to the last st before the gap, p2tog, p1, turn

Continue like this until all sts are knitted. You will now have 20 sts on the needle.  
Pick up 16 sts in each side of the heel flap, and rearrange the stitches on needles like this.

Needle 1 = 25 sts

Needle 2 = 17 sts

Needle 3 = 17 sts

Needle 4 = 25 sts

K one round, before starting decreasing.

Continue knitting the pattern on needle 2 and 3.

Decrease like this:

1.

Needle1:

K to the last 3 sts , k2tog, k1....

Needle4:

K1, ssk, k the rest of the needles

2: Knit

3: as 1.

4: as 2

Continue these 2 round until there are 17 sts on needle 1 and 4, continue working until the sock measures 3 cm than the desired length of the foot.

Toe:

Needle1: K to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1

Needle2: K1, ssk, k to end

Needle3: K to the last 3 sts, k2tog,k1

Needle4: K1, ssk, k to end

Knit next round.

Repeat these 2 rows until there are 8 sts on each needle

Next round: K2tog to end

Knit one round

Next round: k2tog to end.

Pull 8 sts together and fasten the thread. Knit one more sock.
